LIBERTY IN THE PHILIPPINES.
2. (U) BEGINNING 29 MAY 15, LIBERTY IS AUTHORIZED AS OUTLINED BELOW.
 - 2.A. (U) ALL COMMANDING OFFICERS, OICS, OR SENIOR NCO'S WILL DELIVER THE
MANDATORY PACOM ASIA-PACIFIC LIBERTY BRIEF TO EVERY SERVICE MEMBER PRIOR TO
EXECUTING LIBERTY. THE PACOM ASIA-PACIFIC LIBERTY BRIEF CAN BE FOUND ON THE
PACOM THEATER TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS WEBSITE AT [HTTP://PSP-
USA.HQ.PACOM.SMIL.MIL/ORGAREAS/J3/J34/J343/TRAVEL%20REQUIREMENTS/PAGES/DEFAULT.ASPX](http://PSP-USA.HQ.PACOM.SMIL.MIL/ORGAREAS/J3/J34/J343/TRAVEL%20REQUIREMENTS/PAGES/DEFAULT.ASPX) UNDER THE TRAINING AND READINESS SECTION.
 - 2.A.1 (U) TRAINING WILL BE DOCUMENTED FOR EACH SERVICE MEMBER PRIOR TO
LIBERTY EXECUTION.
 - 2.B. (U) ALL SERVICE MEMBERS WILL ADHERE TO THE CDR USPACOM LIBERTY/PASS
POLICY FOR THE PHILIPPINES IN REF E WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT THE ABOVE WEBSITE
IN THE REFERENCE SECTION.
 3. (U) PRIOR TO LIBERTY COMMENCING, COMMANDERS AND OFFICERS IN CHARGE WILL
ENSURE THAT ALL SERVICE MEMBERS ARE BRIEFED ON SPECIFIC LIBERTY GUIDELINES
CONTAINED IN REF E AND ENSURE THAT ALL SERVICE MEMBERS FULLY UNDERSTAND THE
CDR USPACOM PHILIPPINE LIBERTY POLICY.
 4. (U) SERVICE MEMBERS WHO VIOLATE THIS POLICY MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY
ACTION.

5. (U) AT THEIR DISCRETION, COMMANDERS AND OFFICERS IN CHARGE CAN REVOKE LIBERTY FOR SERVICE MEMBERS UNDER THEIR COMMAND.
- 5.A. (U) COMMANDERS WILL IMMEDIATELY REPORT ANY VIOLATIONS OF THIS LIBERTY POLICY TO THEIR CHAIN OF COMMAND FOR FOLLOW ON REPORTING TO THE USPACOM JOINT OPERATIONS CENTER.
