PROGRAM DESCRIPTION/SERVICES PROVIDED

The United States Coast Guard has approximately 2,000 men and women serving throughout the 14th Coast Guard District Area of Responsibility, covering the Pacific Ocean stationed in Hawaii, Guam, Japan, Singapore, Saipan, and American Samoa. The majority of these personnel are assigned to ship or shore commands located on the island of O'ahu.

The Coast Guard's approach to family services encourages strong linkage with community and military resources. Commanding Officers are responsible for providing education, intervention, and referral information to their personnel. In Honolulu, the Work-Life Staff of the Integrated Support Command (ISC) provide family service programs that include: Family Advocacy; Family Child Care; Relocation Assistance; Spouse and Separatee Employment; Family Resources; Special Needs; Employee Assistance; Critical Incident Stress Management; Suicide Prevention; Financial Counseling; Work-Place Violence Prevention; Victim and Witness Advocacy; Child Death Review; Ombudsman Program; Rape and Sexual Assault Victim Advocacy; Adoptions; Scholarships; Nutrition; Addictions; Physical Fitness; and Health Promotion.
