

U.S. PACIFIC FLEET REMEMBRANCE BARGE TOUR REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

What is the Remembrance Barge Tour?

This two-hour tour is a fully narrated boat ride around Ford Island with a stop at the Arizona Memorial, and includes a visit to the Boathouse museum and viewing of a 23- minute movie on the attack on Pearl Harbor.

When are Tours Conducted?

The USPACFLT historic Remembrance Tour is conducted every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. The tour begins at 0900-1100 (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) with a check-in time of 0830, and 1300-1500 (Wednesday Only) with a check-in time of 1230. Guests must have prior reservations, and must check-in at the Pacific Fleet Aiea Landing (Boathouse) to take the tour. Proper **DOD ID** is required.

No standby list is maintained or walk-ins accepted

How do I Book a Tour?

Please email the Boathouse or Protocol Distro (Rank Dependent) with the following information: Name, Rank, Associated Branch, Phone Number, Email address, and how many seats you are trying to reserve.

How Many People may I bring on the Tour with me?

Each authorized person (DOD ID Holder) may sponsor up to 5 additional people, and <u>MUST</u> accompany their party. Spouses of deceased or deployed military personnel may sponsor and <u>MUST</u> escort their guests.

May children go on the tour?

For safety, children must be eight years of age to embark on the Remembrance Barge Tour. Our barges are not equipped with life vests for smaller children. Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam and the National Park Service's boats are able to accommodate younger children.

What are the Uniform/Dress Code Requirements for the Tour?

Attire for all active duty military personnel (including those in a leave status): Navy: Dress White (E6 & Below)/Summer White (E7 & Above) Marine Corps: Service "C" Army: Army Green ASU/Tropical "B" Coast Guard: Tropical Blue Air Force: Service Uniform/Class "B"

Civilians: High heels, flip-flops of any kind, sandals without a back strap, short skirts, extremely inappropriate short shorts, cut offs, drug or alcohol related tops, and tank tops are **NOT** allowed. Closed-toed shoes are required. Backpacks, bags, purses or camera bags are **NOT** permitted on the Arizona Memorial. Cameras are ok, without cases.

Remember, you are paying respects to our Fallen Heroes. Please wear proper Memorial attire.

Those that are not in compliance with Uniform Requirements and Civilian Attire Rules, will be refused entry by the Boathouse OIC.

SPECIAL REMEMBRANCE BARGE TOUR INFORMATION

When are Special Tours Conducted?

Special Remembrance Tours are available for reservation on Tuesdays and Thursdays, with a start time of 1300 or 1600. These tours are not to interfere with the regularly scheduled Remembrance Tour. Special Remembrance Tours are first come first serve and may be canceled or postponed due to unpredicted weather, maintenance issues, and/or other operational requirements.

When may I submit a Tour Reservation Request and What information do I need to Provide?

Special Remembrance Barge Requests can be submitted 60 days in advance and no less than two weeks in advance. Requests must include at least 80% of the complete guest list with the full name of each person attending the tour with ranks and/or official titles. The Remembrance barge is required a minimum of 15 personnel and a maximum of 35.
