- 4. **Express interest in the region**: This command is committed to the defense and security of our nation, partners, and allies within the Indo-Pacific region. If the problem set, issues, cultures, and ultimately the people, do not inspire you to pursue future career plans working in this region then this may not be the program for you.
- Display relevant knowledge: Every student in this program is expected to have a basic understanding of defense/security studies, U.S. and foreign policy, and a working knowledge of the policies that affect this region.
- 6. **Show work history:** The ability to acquire and maintain employment is something we look for in our applicants.
